Your pathway to becoming an Electrician

- Register and pay online for a Texas Apprentice Electrical Licenses (TAEL)
 - a. <https://www.tdlr.texas.gov/>
 - b. You should receive your license in 1-2 weeks via mail

- Bring TAEL and Driver License to our office and fill out a job application
 - a. CenTex IEC, 8868 Research Blvd Suite 502, Austin
 - b. Mon – Thu between 1-5pm

- Be ready for an interview with prospective employers that contact you
 - a. Set a professional outgoing voicemail on your phone
 - b. Show up dressed appropriately
 - c. Be excited and inquisitive during the interview

- Once Hired:
 - a. Contact our office to remove your application from our web site
 - b. We have a discounted rate on starter tool kits, contact us for info
 - c. Let your employer know you are interested in attending our Apprenticeship Program

- CenTex IEC - Apprenticeship Program:
 - a. Shows the employer your desire to excel in your profession
 - b. More knowledge typically equates to more money and more prestigious and higher paying positions
 - c. There is a wage scale progression contractors have to follow in compensating CenTex IEC students. Wage scale dictates approx. \$1.20 raise each semester.
 - d. After completing the 4-yr Apprenticeship Program students will be ready to take their Journeyman Exam through the State of Texas
 - e. After becoming a Journeyman Electrician opportunities will begin to open for/to:
(Crew Leader, Job Foreman, Project Manager, Service Tech, Estimator, CAD or even a Business Owner)
