

## HOW TO ENROLL

- ◆ Complete an application at the IEC office, Monday - Thursday, 1:00PM - 5:00PM. (Two (2) forms of I.D. are required one of which must be a valid driver's license).
- ◆ Become or be employed by an IEC Contractor Member or be available to go to work for one.
- ◆ Must possess a High School Diploma or GED.
- ◆ Have reliable transportation (preferably your own vehicle), to get to and from classes and the jobsites.
- ◆ Be skillful in math and reading.
- ◆ Interview with the IEC's Apprenticeship & Training Committee.

IEC is a trade association that has been providing electrical training for more than 30 Years to over 3,000 member contractors across the nation.

## Certifications of the program

The U.S. Department of Labor, Office of Apprenticeship and Training certifies the IEC's Electrical Apprenticeship Program. Upon completion of the program requirements, you will receive a certificate from IEC National and the U.S. Department of Labor certifying you as a Journeyman Electrician.

Additionally the IEC is certified by the Veterans Administration enabling veterans to receive their VA benefits. Also the electrical apprenticeship program is registered with the American Council on Education allowing our apprentices to receive college credits.

## PROGRAM OPERATION

You must be working for an IEC contractor member before classes begin. IEC staff will attempt to assist you with employment once accepted into the program. You must continue to work for your IEC contractor member to continue with the program.

## CLASS SCHEDULE AND LOCATION

Classes start every September. Apprentices attend school one night per week, 4-hours per class for a minimum of 36 weeks. Class times are typically from 5:00PM to 9:00PM. Classes are held in Austin, Killeen and Waco facilities.

## APPRENTICES' RESPONSIBILITY

**ACADEMICS** - Class attendance is critical. No more than 3 absences per school year are permitted.

A 70% passing grade each year must be maintained to continue to the next year of classroom training.

**WORK ETHIC** - We expect the highest level of work ethics to be displayed by the apprentices while working for one of our contractor members. Attendance, reliability, awareness to safety, initiative and a positive attitude are the attributes of an IEC Apprentice.
